The Spivey Hall Honor Workshops seek not only to give young people the rare opportunity to perform in a world-class concert hall but also to develop their talents through music and interaction with other dedicated students. **Student scholarships are available.** The fee is \$70. You will also be required to purchase sheet music that is \$15 + shipping. You will also be required to have the appropriate concert attire. In the past it has been black pants and a white top but Spivey will confirm this if you are accepted.

- Participants must be talented musicians, well-behaved students, and available for every rehearsal in its entirety. The full schedule is listed below.
- Students must be nominated by a music educator to participate. Nomination does not guarantee participation.
- Accepted participants must commit to the full schedule. Sat October 5, 10-5; Thu Oct 10, 5pm-8:00pm; Fri Oct 11, 10am-4pm; Sat Oct 12, 10am-7pm
- You are responsible for transportation and supervision at rehearsals.
- If your student is accepted, you will receive an email from Spivey Hall and will make payment directly to Spivey.
- Students accepted by Spivey Hall will be scheduled for Vocal Studio during IF on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays in order to prepare for the event.
