Thomas County 4-H assists MERIT students in several ways!

- ***** Becoming a member of Thomas County 4-H satisfies the requirement for an extracurricular activity. We typically meet once per month during exploratory time
- ***** There are no club dues to join
- **W**e do several community service projects throughout the year
- We have many competitions that satisfy the requirement for an academic competition
- In addition to being a part of a great organization and being able to compete in academic competitions, Thomas 4-H has many other activities that students can become involved in including;

<u>Thomas County 4-H Horse Program</u> – Meet once per month after school at the 4-H office (227 West Jefferson), you do not need to own a horse to join, activity fee \$20

<u>Thomas County Livestock Program</u> – Age requirements for the different species – hogs, steers, heifers, lambs and goats. Contact the 4-H office for age requirements and tagging deadlines

<u>Thomas County 4-H Shooting Sports Program</u> – For 7th graders and above only! Other requirements to join including Hunter's Safety Course, sponsorship required, contact the 4-H office for more info

<u>Summer Camping Program</u> - Our 5th and 6th graders will be camping at Camp Fortson in Hampton, GA June 27 through July 1. We have easy payment plans! In fact you can begin making payments now! We also have fundraisers in the spring to assist!
