

Discontinued Math Classes:

- Liberal Arts Math 1 (Student will instead move to Geometry)
- Financial Algebra (Replaced with Math for Data & Financial Literacy)
 - Prerequisite: Geometry
 - 1 Math Credit Grades: 11-12
 - In Mathematics for Data and Financial Literacy, instructional time will emphasize five areas: (1) extending knowledge of ratios, proportions and functions to data and financial contexts; (2) developing understanding of basic economic and accounting principles; (3) determining advantages and disadvantages of credit accounts and short- and long-term loans;(4) developing understanding of planning for the future through investments, insurance and retirement plans and (5) extending knowledge of data analysis to create and evaluate reports and to make predictions.

Trig/Analysis and Functions (Typically students move to Pre-Calc or Statistics)



INTENSIVE READING

If it is determined that you need reading enhancement based on your grade FSA ELA scores, 1 of your electives will be replaced by Intensive Reading.



INTENSIVE MATH

If it is determined that you need math enhancement to pass your Algebra 1 EOC, 1 of your electives will be replaced by Intensive Math.
