

GSE Honors PreCalculus Course Syllabus

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Course Description:

This is a course in PreCalculus designed to prepare students to take Calculus in a college or university at the end of successful completion of high school. The following is a list of what will be covered:

- 4. TI-84 is recommended but a TI-36XPro will do 90% of what we need.

- 6. Colored pencils/glue sticks

Textbook Used: HMH PreCalculus - online version (called WileyPlus)

Classroom Expectations: This school year will begin with remote online learning. It is the expectation that students will log in to google meet using their assigned Henry County login for every class meeting. It is recommended that students use their assigned Henry County Chromebook for classroom meetings. It is required that students use their assigned Henry County Chromebook for all test and quizzes.
