What Could a Teacher Buy with Supply Funds?

Suggested Items:

Pencils, Pens, Crayons, Markers, Highlighters, Arts & Craft Materials

Paper, Folders, Binder Pouch, Binders, Paper Cut Outs, Books

Aprons, Baskets, Plastic Bins or Storage Boxes

Flash Cards, Math Manipulatives

Chalk Boards, Dry Erase Boards, Maps, Charts, Posters, Globes

DVD/CDs, Protective Covers for Tablets, Head Phones, Keyboard, Mouse

Game Balls and Supplies (for PE)

Purchases of food or greeting cards used in a planned lesson

Expendable items, having characteristics of equipment, but with a unit cost that is less than \$50.

Not Allowable:

Clothing, Shoes, Jewelry, Handbags

Furniture, Equipment, Computers, Tablets, Speakers, Printers, over \$50

Gifts, Gift Cards

Travel, Hotels or Conference Registrations

Medications, Pesticides, Cleaning Supplies or Solvents, Cleaning Chemicals

Software, Licenses, Memberships

Per Florida Statute 1012.71(2) these funds are to be used to purchase "classroom materials and supplies for the public school students assigned to them and may not be used to purchase equipment."
