WCHS Registration




- Print out your schedule on MyStudent


Printing Schedules

- Print out your schedule




Printing Bus Pass

Paying Student Fees


- On the My Portal page, find and click on Pay Student Fees

- Print out the receipts for parking passes, lockers, etc. and bring them into school during the first week to receive them








Please familiarize yourself with the map of the school and notice the arrows. This is the preferred travel during passing to promote social distancing.







Cafeteria Procedures

There will be six points of sale for students purchasing their lunches. Six sales points in the cafeteria, and one sales point in the old teacher lounge. There will be signage on the floor directing the students into the cafeteria while also promoting social distancing on the floor (arrows for which way to go spaced six feet apart). Once a student has their lunch, they will be directed to exit the cafeteria through the exit only door. If the student chooses to eat in the cafeteria, they can sit at of the limited number of seats. There will be additional seating under the covered area as well as tables set up in front of the Media Center and in between the PAC and Gym. In the event of inclement weather, the Gym and Media Center will be used for seating.




Cafeteria Entrance/Exit Procedure

marked with Wildcat Paw Prints to follow.






Here is a list of supplies that will be helpful as you enter school traditionally:




Schedule Change REQUESTS Information

Schedule changes will be limited to one of the following reasons:


- The student is registered for a course where credit has already been earned.




