

5th GRADE MUSIC CLASS RECORDERS ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED NOW THROUGH SEPTEMBER 15TH

5th graders are excited about learning to play the recorder!! There are lots of recorders in the music room that the students may use. These recorders are disinfected after each user. If you already own a soprano recorder you can use it in music class. However, please do not buy Dollar Store recorders as they do not play in tune. Owning a recorder is strongly encouraged but not mandatory. For your convenience, the school sells recorders.

Recorder Option 1: Nuvo Recorder Plus

a	(black with blue, green or black flaps depending on the availability when the order is placed)	
Cost:	\$14.00	
Description:	This recorder has silicone flaps over the holes. It is easier to play because you	
	press the flap and "tah-duh" it seals the hole. Also, it has an adjustable thumb	-
	rest that makes it easier to hold. Less squeaking! Yeah!	
Fun Fact:	Saxophones and flutes have keys that seal the holes like this recorder.	
Included:	Recorder, adjustable thumb rest, and hard plastic case.	

Recorder Option 2: Traditional Angel Soprano Recorder

Cost:	\$7.00
Description:	This recorder has open holes. It is more difficult to play because you must seal the holes with your
-	fingers. "If it leaks, it squeaks!" Yikes!
Fun Fact:	Clarinets have lots of open holes like this recorder.
Included:	Recorder, soft plastic case, and neck strap.

Payment Option 1: SchoolPay

The easiest way to order a recorder is to use your child's SchoolPay account. This method provides an immediate receipt and alleviates confusion/lost payments. It also removes the responsibility of payment from your student.

Payment Option 2: Enclose payment and order form in an envelope and turn it in to Mrs. Suppa or the office.

Checks: Make them out to PVPV/Rawlings Elementary

On the bottom left side of the check please write your child's name and homeroom teacher's name. Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt.

Cash: Send in exact change.

Monies less than \$10.00 will not receive a receipt.

Financial Assistance: Please allow your student to try the recorders available in music class. After a few weeks, if your child really enjoys the recorder and wants one so that he/she can practice at home, please Mrs. Suppa a note and she will issue your child a donated Angel Soprano Recorder (used disinfected or new, depending on what she has available).

Distribution: When the recorders arrive, the music teacher will write the students' names on their cases and engrave their first and last names on their recorders. If you would like to volunteer to help complete this task, please email <u>Linda.suppa@stjohns.k12.fl.us</u>. After the recorders are labelled, Mrs. Suppa will hand the recorders out in music class.

<u>Storage</u>: Students should keep their recorders in their backpacks so they can practice at home and have them for music class.
