#### Learning Targets:

**2nd/3rd Grade Writing** - I can write a narrative where I recount an event or short series of events, include details to describe actions, thoughts, and feelings, use temporal words to signal event order, and provide a sense of closure.

**5th Grade ELA** - I can write an opinion piece where I have an introduction, state my opinion, and supply reasons.

I can identify a fictional story with character traits, settings, and events by drawing inferences, and explaining what the text says explicitly from the text. (fiction - literary text)

I can determine two or more main ideas of a text and explain how they are supported by key details; summarize the text. (nonfiction - informational text)

**5th Grade Math** - I can convert among different-sized standard measurement units (mass, weight, length, time, etc.) within a given measurement system (customary and metric) (e.g., convert 5cm to 0.05m), and use these conversions in solving multi-step, real-world problems.

#### 2nd/3rd Grade Writing

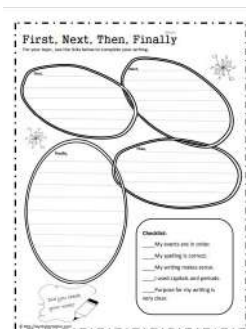
