

West Forsyth Physical Education Department Policies

Students are expected to dress out daily in covered shoes and a West Forsyth PE Shirt and to bring your own athletic wear for shorts or leg coverings. The cost of the PE shirt is \$10 and the lock is \$5 (per semester/year). These can be purchased separately or as a set. This uniform must not be altered or damaged in any way. However, we are requiring the student's name to be written somewhere on the shirt. Failure to keep a uniform in good condition will result in the need for the student to purchase another one. Please see your teacher to purchase your uniform and/or your lock.

Dressing out is expected. The student will receive a weekly summative grade based on dressing out. Each day is worth 20 points (40 on block days) of their summative grade. Any student not dressed out for the day will be expected to walk for their daily activity. *Improper shoes will be counted as not dressing out. (Closed toed shoes with rubber non-marking soles only allowed on the gym floor)*

The following is a breakdown of your weekly participation grade. Each day of the week is worth 20 points (40 on block days) of their weekly summative grade. Students will be given periodic formative assessments in each unit. This assessment will reflect the standards for the given class.

Also, grading will be based on: Formative (25%) + Summative (75%)

A doctor's note should include specific limitations, restrictions and length of inactivity. This must be completed and turned in directly to your PE teacher.

The locker rooms will not be open until 8:20am daily. NO exceptions. NO food is allowed in the locker room.

Locker rooms are only used as a restroom and as dress out facilities. Locks will be sold during the 2021-22 school year.

If a student arrives as an excused (with a pass from a faculty member) or unexcused tardy they are to go to directly to their teacher.

Students are to use the locker rooms for restrooms. Only 1 student is allowed at a time, and the student must have the teacher's permission. Please bring your own water bottle for PE.

If a student is aware that he/she will be checking out, they are not to dress for class. (They would not be allowed back in the locker room to change when they would need to leave).

The locker rooms will be secured and locked at 3:40pm daily. NO students or athletes will be allowed to enter until 8:20am the next school day.

It is the students' responsibility to secure their belongings in a locker. WFHS is not responsible in any way for your items. PLEASE have your student lock their items (valuables) in a locker.

Students are not allowed to leave the gym, field and/or any instructional area without the teacher's permission. While cell phones are allowed at WFHS they may not interfere with the educational process in PE class. A lack of participation in class due to cell phone use will result in loss in participation points.

No food, drink or gum is allowed in the gym. Detentions will be assigned for violations of this rule. All detentions will be served with the teacher who assigned the detention. Failure to serve will result in an office referral.

Please line up for roll in your designated area every day when signaled by your coach. It is department policy that you must sit when in roll line. Thanks for your cooperation.

Teachers reserve the right to change any section of the course outline at any time during the course to more adequately meet the needs, abilities and interests of the students.
