Library Policies & Procedures

- ✓ Book checkout and SSYRA book reviews (brag tags) only during resource class time (elementary)
- ✓ Book request forms and SSYRA Book Review forms will be available both in print format and digitally (middle school and distance learners)
- ✓ Books/SSYRA Brag Tags will be delivered to homerooms (brick & mortar) or via curbside pickup (distance learners)
- ✓ Books can be checked out for 3 weeks at a time and will be quarantined for 72 hours once returned
- ✓ K-1st grade can check out one book, 2nd grade can check out two books, and 3rd - 8th grades can check out three books at a time.


