## Wildkit Engineering Camp

This camp is based on the national Project Lead the Way pre-engineering program and utilizes project-based, hands-on approach to STEM learning (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics).

Campers will engage in daily design challenges to enhance their problem-based STEM skills such as problem-solving, critical thinking, and teamwork. Campers will create designs, build prototypes, test, and evaluate their results.

## Wildkit food Adventure Camp

Campers will engage their minds in uncovering where our food comes from, how it fuels our bodies and the science behind baking. Campers will develop basic skills for cooking nutritious meals and snacks.

- Eating the Rainbow: How do colorful foods make you healthy?
- Food for Thought: What do baking and chemistry have in common?
