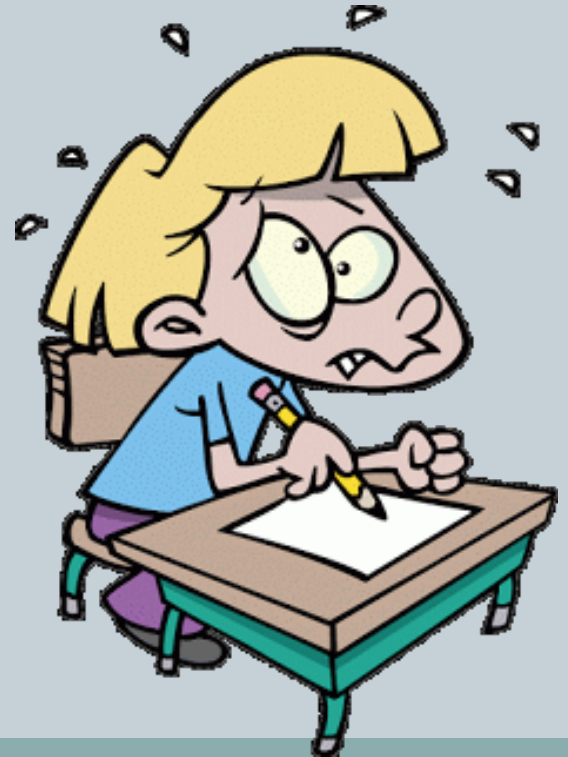

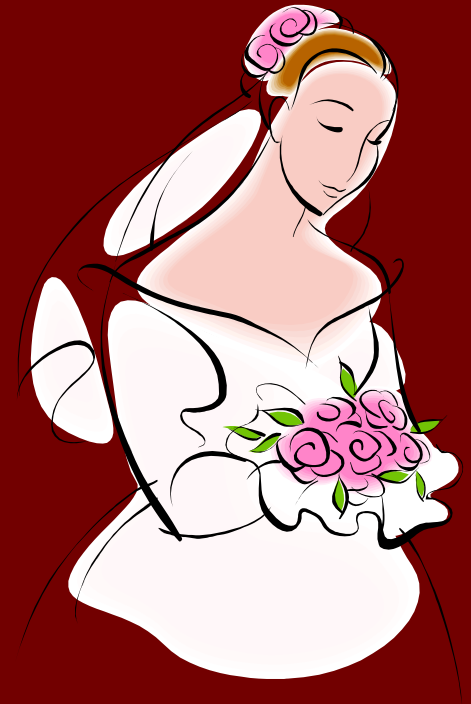
matr

■ “mother”



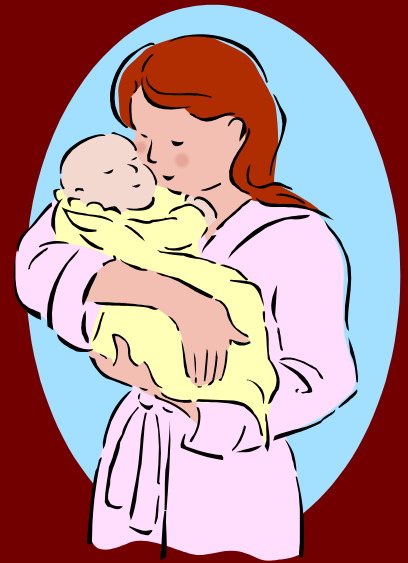
matron

- Antonym: uncaring



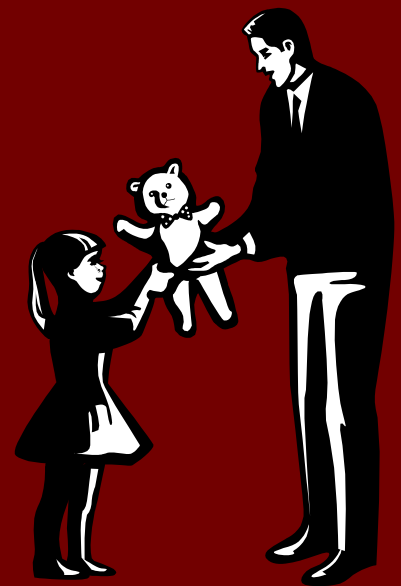
matriculate

- Definition 1: To regularly give business to
- Definition 2: To talk down to; condescend

- Adjective
- Having the qualities of a father
- synonym: fatherly
- Antonym: uncaring



patricide

- Noun
- The murder of a father



cide = killer; act of killing

- homicide
- matricide
- fratricide
- pesticide/herbicide
- suicide
- genocide

expatriate

- Noun
- A person living outside his or her native country
- Synonym: emigrant
- Antonym: native

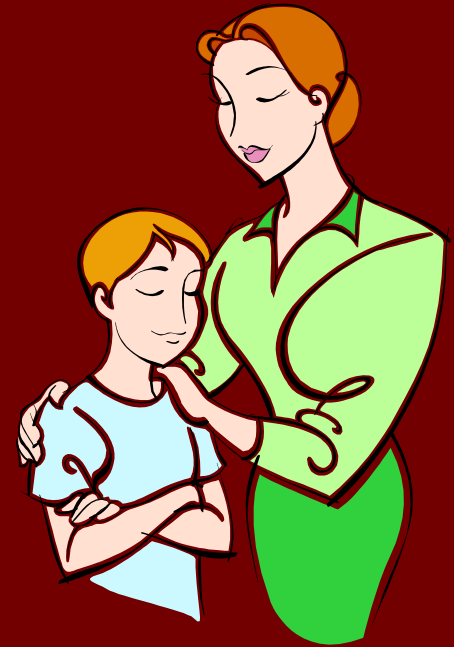
fil

- Having to do with a son or child

- Noun
- Act of a parent killing a child

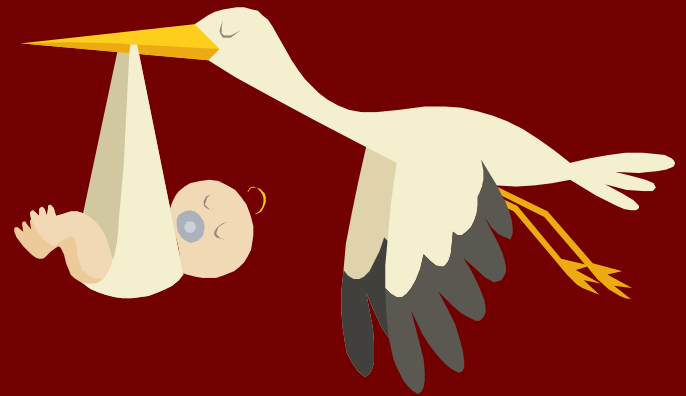
affiliate/affiliation

- Synonym: partner
- Antonym: rival



gen

■ “give birth to; create”



progenitor

- noun
- The founder of a line or race
- Synonym: forefather
- Antonym: descendant



progeny

- noun
- Children or descendants
- Synonym: offspring



genealogy

- Noun
- The study of families and descendants



genetics

- Noun
- The study of heredity
[characteristics passed down from parent to offspring]
