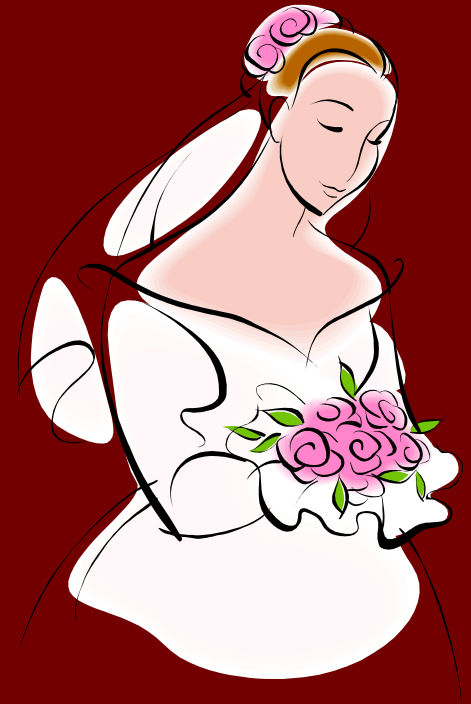

- Antonym: uncaring



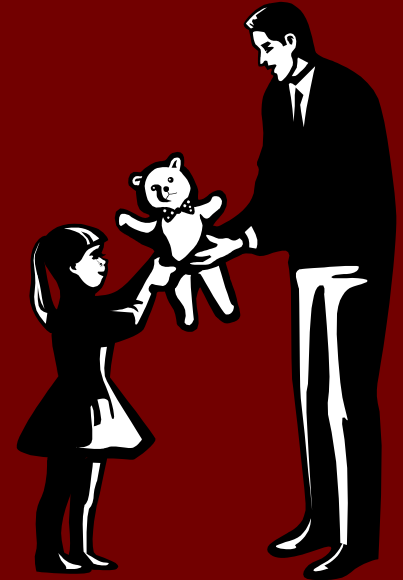
# matriculate

# expatriate

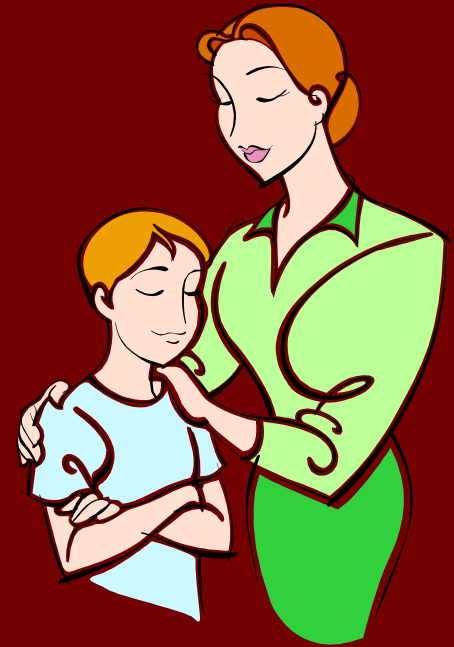
- Noun

- Having to do with a son



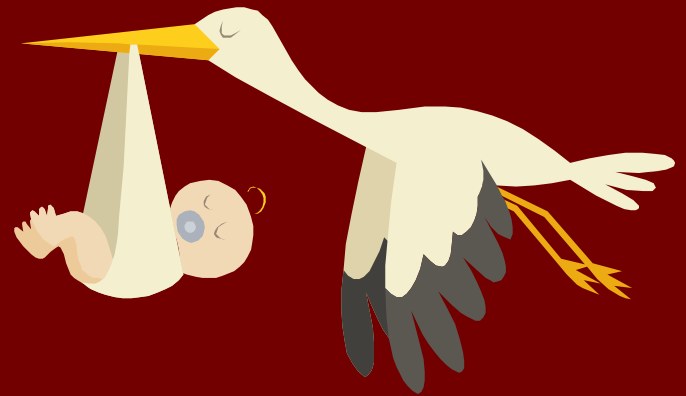
# affiliate
