- A brief statement that conveys a general truth
- Synonym: proverb



**min**

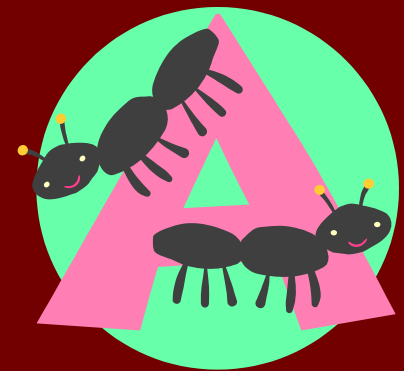
■ “less; to lessen”

- verb
- To make smaller; lessen
- synonym: reduce
- Antonym: add to; build

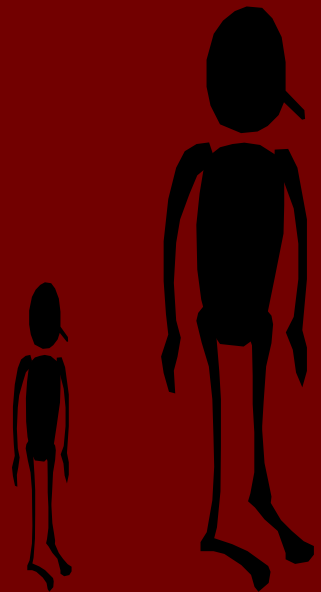
# miniscule

- tiny
- Synonym: insignificant



# minute

- adjective
- Extremely small; insignificant
- Synonym: microscopic
- Antonym: enormous

- Adjective
- Done with attention to small details
- Synonym: painstaking
- Antonym: careless



# microcosm

- Noun
- A small model of a larger pattern or place
