- 3. Finish: Must be printed professionally in color (See Mr. Matthews for best options)
- 4. Diagrams and Illustrations: Six diagrams and illustrations minimum. All are in focus and the content easily viewed and identified from 6 ft. away.
- 5. Source Citation / Bibliography: All sources used for quotes, facts, diagrams, and illustrations have a source citation on a separate page. (See MLA Format Citation Guide)
