Notes:

- College-bound students must take two years of the same language. Some colleges, outside of the state of Florida, may NOT accept ASL as a foreign language requirement. Please check with your prospective school to determine if credit will be awarded. Two years of a world language is only required for a four-year university. Community colleges do not have this requirement.

- Students with a D in level one, will not be allowed to move to level 2. They will repeat level 1.

- Students moving up to level 3 and 4 must demonstrate an A/B in previous two classes.
