Request for Teacher Access to YouTube

Network Information:

Thomas County Schools Technology Department understands that some websites such as YouTube contain valuable education resources that may be used for teaching in the classroom. However, it is important to also realize this same website contains inappropriate resources that should never be accessible by students. According to the Children's Internet Protection Act, it is the law and our duty as educators to protect students from inappropriate content found on the Internet.

The rights to the network and websites are determined through your network login (the username and password you use to log into computers at school). Students' logins are more restricted than teachers'. For this reason, a teacher should *never* log into computers being used by students with their teacher username and password. Teachers should not leave their computer logged in and unattended while students are present. Each student has his or her own username and password to access computers and our network. If at any time you feel your teacher login has been compromised, please ask your school technology contact to change your password.
