Graduation Requirements

- ▣ Complete 24 Required Credits or
- ▣ 18 credit graduation plan
(Both are standard diplomas)
- ▣ Have a cumulative GPA of 2.000
- ▣ Pass the FSA and/or EOC exam
 - Reading
 - Math
 - PERT twice a month
 - PERT Boot Camp-information to come

18 Credit Academically Challenging Curriculum to Enhance Learning (ACCEL)

- ▣ All other graduation requirements for a 24-credit standard diploma must be met (per section 1003.4282(3)-(e), Florida Statute[F.S.]).
- ▣ Only 3 electives are required, instead of 8.
- ▣ **No** HOPE/PE credit is required.
- ▣ **No** online course is required.

Credit Recovery Options

- ▣ -Adult Education (AKA night School at ZHS)
- ▣ - Online Classes (FLVS / Pasco eSchool)
- ▣ APEX
- ▣ SOS
- ▣ Students may only repeat courses in which a **D** or **F** was earned for a semester.

SAT Non-Reportable

- ▣ Wednesday, 10/16/2019
- ▣ All Seniors who have not passed their Reading Requirement for graduation will take this test.
- ▣ Cost: Free
- ▣ Scores are non-college reportable, only for graduation requirements.
- ▣ Students will receive time and a half for all sections.

ACT/SAT Concordant Scores

- ▣ PSAT =
 - Math: 430 Reading: n/a
- ▣ ACT =
 - Math: 16 Reading: 19
- ▣ SAT =
 - Math: 420 Reading: 430
- ▣ PERT =
 - Math: 97 Reading: n/a

University Admissions

- ▣ Need 18 academic credits (Eng. Math, Science, Social Studies, Foreign Lang. 2 academic credits)
- ▣ Need **2 years of the SAME** Foreign Language
- ▣ Need to take SAT and/or ACT
- ▣ Test scores and GPA must be competitive

Florida Academic Scholars Requirements

- ▣ 1290 SAT or 29 ACT Composite
- ▣ 3.5 weighted GPA in core academic courses
- ▣ 100 hours of Community Service Hours

Florida Medallion Scholars Requirements

- ▣ 1170 SAT or 26 ACT Composite
- ▣ 3.0 weighted GPA in core academic courses
- ▣ 75 Community Service Hours

Gold Seal Vocational Scholars

- ▣ SAT: Reading 440 Math 440
- ▣ ACT: English 17 Reading 19 Math 19
- ▣ PERT: Reading 106 Writing 103 Math 114
- ▣ Need 3.0 in core academic courses
- ▣ Need 3.5 in 3 sequential and approved vocational courses
- ▣ 30 Community Service hours

Other Bright Futures Requirements

- ▣ Must successfully complete 2 years of a foreign language
- ▣ Not guilty of a felony
- ▣ Use Award within 2 years of graduation
- ▣ Attend a Florida College or University (Public or Private)
- ▣ Must complete a Florida Student Financial Aid Application(FFAA) no later than Aug. 31st of your graduation year.

Senior Year College Timeline

Your senior year is when your hard work and planning pay off. Complete college applications in the fall, and be aware of deadlines.

- ▣ **September-** Meet with your counselor/career specialist to discuss your college plans. Go over your ACT and/or SAT scores and determine if you need to retake either of these tests.

Timeline Continued

- ▣ **October-** Complete college admissions and financial aid applications. Be sure to apply to at least one “safety school.”
- ▣ College Application deadline Nov. 1st
- ▣ Retake the ACT and/or SAT if necessary.
- ▣ Complete FAFSA Application online at www.fafsa.gov, opens Oct. 1st

Timeline Continued

- ▣ **November-** Continue to work on Community Service Hours!
- ▣ **December** – Retake the ACT and/or SAT if necessary.
- ▣ **Jan-March-** Seek out and complete local scholarship opportunities. See ZHS College & Career Resource website.
- ▣ **April** – Decide which college to attend, return award letters, and if you plan to live on campus, send in your housing deposit.
