# 18 Credit Academically Challenging Curriculum to Enhance Learning (ACCEL)

- All other graduation requirements for a 24-credit standard diploma must be met (per section 1003.4282(3)-(e), Florida Statute[F.S.]).
- Only 3 electives are required, instead of 8.
- No HOPE/PE credit is required.
- No online course is required.

#### **Credit Recovery Options**

- -Adult Education (AKA Night School at ZHS)
- Online Classes (FLVS / Pasco eSchool)
- APEX
- SOS
- Students may only repeat courses in which a D or an F was earned for a semester.

### **ACT Non-College Reportable**

- Tuesday & Wednesday, March 2nd & 3rd
- All Juniors & Seniors who have not passed their Reading or Math requirement, are eligible to take this test.
- Cost: \$35
- Scores are non-college reportable; only for graduation requirements.
- Students will receive triple-time for all sections.
- Students only need to sit for the sections of the test they need.

#### Filing the FAFSA

#### Financial aid for college starts with the FAFSA

Completing and submitting a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the single most important thing you can do to get financial aid for college.

#### What do you need?

If you're a dependent student, you'll need this information for you and your parents

- ✓ Social Security number
- ✓ Alien Registration number (if you aren't a U.S. citizen)
- ✓ Federal income tax return, W-2s, and other records of money earned; you may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.
- ✓ Bank statements and investment records (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- ✓ You will need an FSA (Federal Student Aid) ID to sign the form electronically. You can get your FSA ID here: fafsa.ed.gov



If your financial aid status has changed, please complete and submit the FAFSA using the required tax year as directed, then follow up with your school's financial aid office for further advice.



#### Florida Student Scholarship Grant Programs

The Florida Financial Aid Application opens October 1\* of the senior year

\*Apply early - must be completed prior to August 31 of high school graduation year

One application is used for multiple programs, not just the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program

\*Must log-in to check status, online notifications and award history

### Florida Academic Scholars Requirements

100% Tuition, \$300 for books per semester

- 1330 SAT or 29 ACT Composite
- 3.5 weighted GPA in core academic courses
- Must complete 2 years of a Foreign Language
- 100 Community Service Hours

# Florida Medallion Scholars Requirements 75% Tuition

■ 1210 SAT or 25 ACT Composite

■ 3.0 weighted GPA in core academic courses

Must complete 2 years of a Foreign Language

75 Community Service Hours

# Gold Seal Vocational Scholars & Gold Seal CAPE Scholars

Currently paying \$39-\$48 per credit hour

- Need 3.0 in core academic courses
- Need 3.5 in 3 sequential and approved vocational courses
- Must meet testing requirements through ACT, SAT, or PERT
- 30 Community Service Hours
