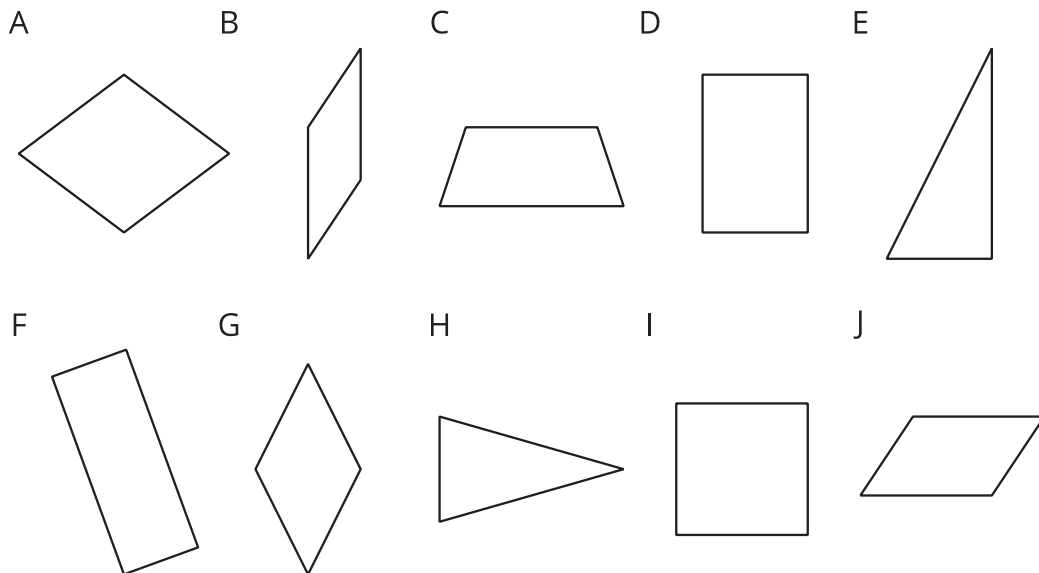
1. These are right triangles.



These are not right triangles.

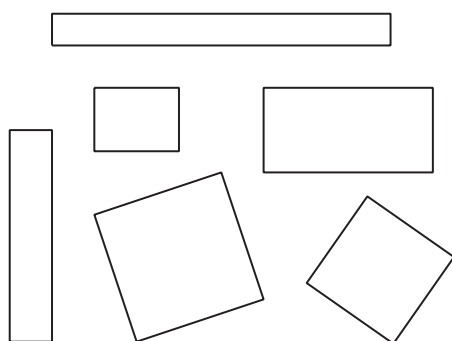

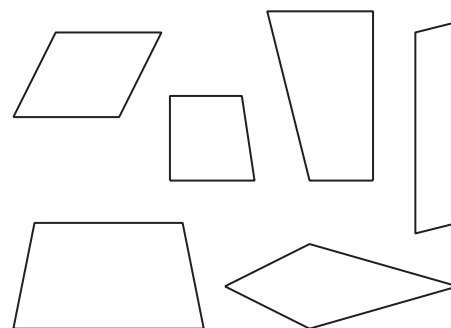

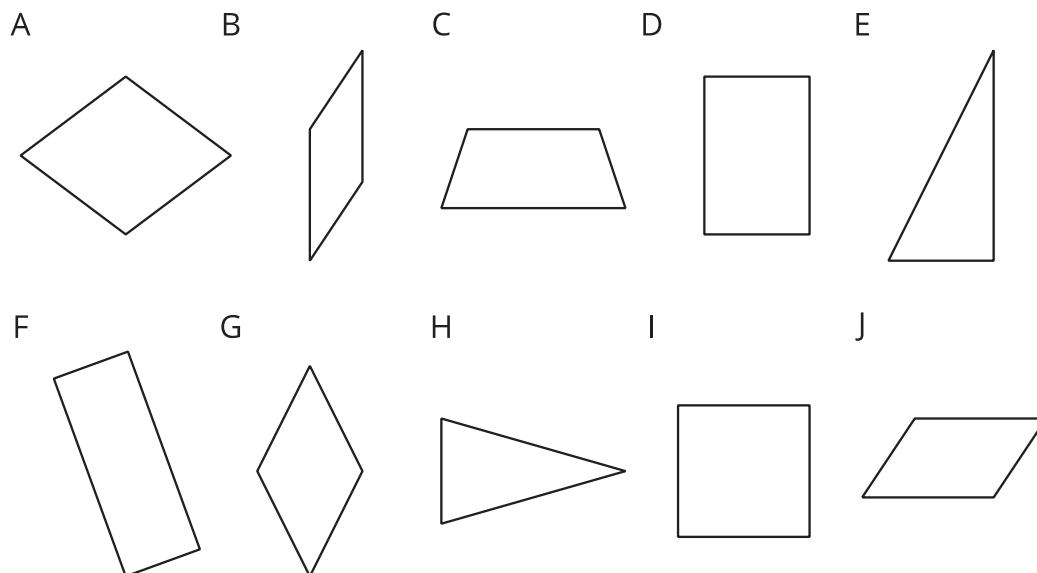
2. These are rectangles.



These are not rectangles.

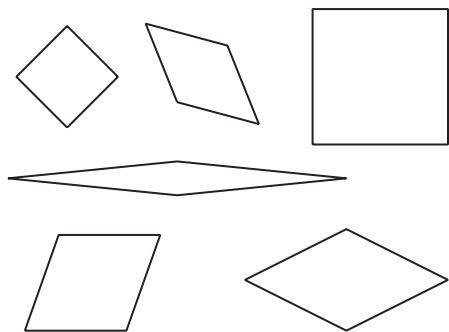


a. Which of the following are rectangles? Circle them.

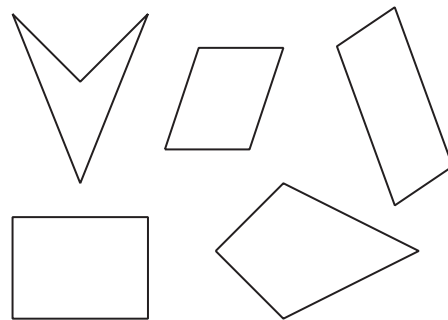

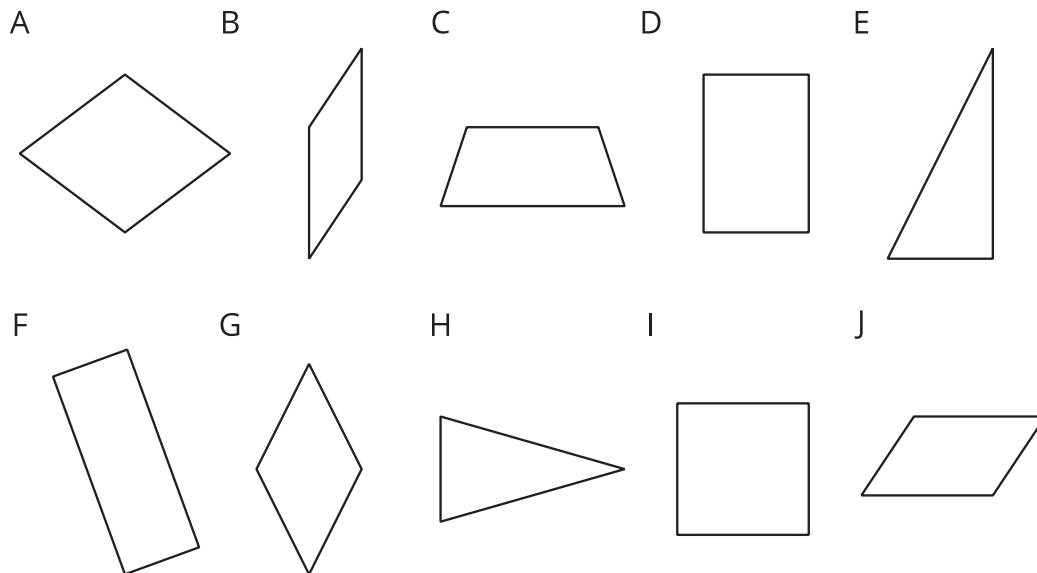
3. These are rhombuses.

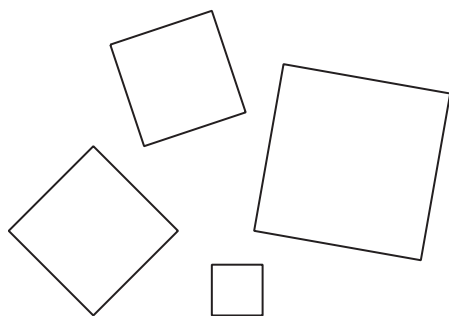

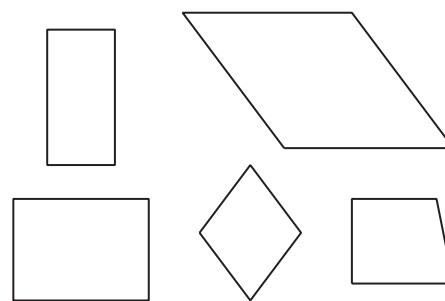

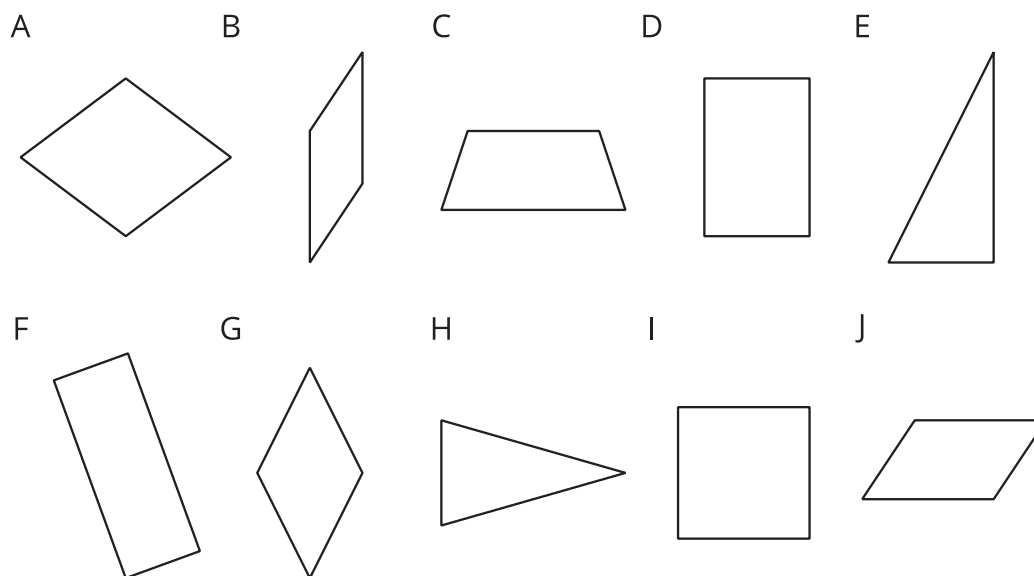
