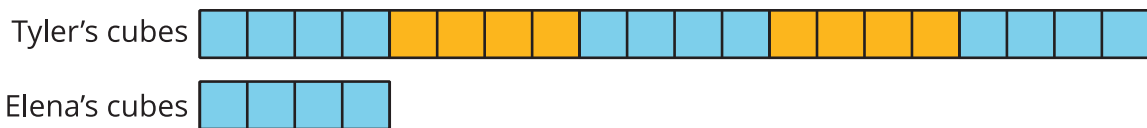


Lesson 2: Interpret Representations of Multiplicative Comparison

Cool Down: Comparing Cubes

1. Circle the statement and the multiplication equation that show a comparison of Tyler's and Elena's cubes.



Tyler has 4 more cubes than Elena.

$$6 \times 4 = 24$$

Elena has 5 times as many cubes as Tyler.

$$2 \times 10 = 20$$

Tyler has 5 times as many cubes as Elena.

$$4 \times 4 = 16$$

Tyler has 4 times as many cubes as Elena.

$$5 \times 4 = 20$$
