## MAKE A SPIDER USING SKIP COUNTING PATTERNS

You can also use a water bottle .with your parent's help

With an adult, cut the bottom of water bottle.

Make 8 small holes in each water bottle bottom.

Glue eyes if desired.

Insert pipe cleaners into holes to form legs.

Add beads to decorate the spiders.

Each leg must be decorated exactly the same as the other seven.

Twist the pipe cleaner just above last bead to fasten all beads on the legs.

Put away extra supplies.
