- Take power away from the aristocracy, church, parliaments, diets, etc.



#### Frederick II of Prussia

- Previous knowledge, what do we already know about him?
- Sparked the war of Austrian Succession when he invaded Silesia.
- Sparked the Seven Years War when he invaded Saxony.

- Wrote history, literary criticisms, and music






## **Religious Toleration**


## **Catherine the Great**

- Imposed religious, legal, and social reforms.
