Creating Performing Responding Connecting

Singing a variety of repertoire alone and with others

- Perform with limited guidance, music for a specific purpose while using a variety of expressive qualities such as dynamics and tempo
- Perform from memory and from iconic notation songs representing genres and styles from diverse cultures while connecting to students' own experiences
- Perform with limited guidance, musical concepts such as steady beat and melodic contour
- Create, read, and perform rhythmic patterns using iconic or standard notation
- Perform as a group, responding to the cues of a conductor
- Create and perform different vocal timbres

Playing on instruments a variety of repertoire, alone and with others

- Perform with proper technique, steady beat and rhythmic accuracy
- Perform in ensembles, listening and responding to each other and a conductor
- Perform simple accompaniments using a variety of instruments
- Create and perform rhythmic and melodic ideas on instruments

Movement

- Perform, within a group, a simple choreographed dance
- Create and perform simple patterns using body percussion or props
- Respond to music and each other through a variety of expressive movements
- Build physical and emotional connections in a positive way through community movement
