I CAN statements for Music during 1st Quarter

*These are statements the students recite each music class and coincide with the Shakopee Music curriculum and National Music Standards.

*These I CAN statements are learned through: active listening, singing, playing instruments, moving, dancing, circle games and listening to musical stories.

Kindergarten

- I CAN sing a welcome song
- I CAN use my voice in different ways
- I CAN make my voice go high and low
- I CAN move safely in the music room
- I CAN move to sound and stop to silence

1st grade

- I CAN move to a steady beat
- I CAN use my 4 different voices (whisper, speaking, singing, calling)
- I CAN echo the teacher using my singing voice
- I CAN identify high and low pitches

2nd grade

- I CAN move to a steady beat
- I CAN perform rhythm patterns (including quarter notes, rests and eighth notes)
- I CAN sing the pitches so, mi and la
- I CAN identify music symbols

3rd grade

- I CAN sing on pitch with others
- I CAN perform rhythm patterns (including quarter notes, rests, eighth notes, half and dotted half notes)
- I CAN identify the form of a piece of music
- I CAN identify a percussion and string instrument by their sound

4th grade

- I CAN sing a song in canon
- I CAN identify musical symbols
- I CAN name notes on the staff
- I CAN identify meter

5th grade

- I CAN name the Elements of Music (pitch, melody, beat, rhythm, tempo, dynamics, timbre, form)
- I CAN sing an American folk song
- I CAN use the Element of Music words to describe Native American music
