## Congratulations and welcome to the team of paras and aides for Great Falls Public Schools!

As a condition of employment, GFPS requires paras and aides to obtain highly qualified status. This is determined by the attainment of an academic degree, college credit hours, or meeting the required benchmarks in Reading and Math using the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE). These proctored online tests will be administered at Great Falls College by the Great Falls Career & College Readiness Center, 2100 16<sup>th</sup> Ave. S, Room G-30 (southeast side door).

If you have an associate's degree or higher or have completed at least two years of study at an institution of higher education, you are considered Highly Qualified! Contact Sandy Bennett in Human Resources at 406-268-6087.

The TABE is given to assess the need for academic support. **You cannot fail!** If you do not meet the minimum benchmark in Reading or Math, you will do some skill building with the support of the CCRC and retest. **There is NO preparation** for the initial exam.

## Note: The district requires that you complete testing within six (6) weeks of receiving this letter!

Human Resources is expecting you to comply by doing the following:
