3. Naviance College Application Information (SENIORS):

- Any senior who plans to apply to college will use their Naviance accounts to build a college list and request letters of recommendations and transcripts from counselors and/or teachers
- College applications will be sent separately, by using Common Application (for those who accept it) or the college's specific admission application; most applications are submitted online
- For those using Common Application, you must link this account to your Naviance account, using the Common App Match; watch the video on the guidance website, which explains how to do this
- Print out the **Naviance College Application Procedures** handout on the guidance website & stop by the CCC, Rm. 116 for additional help

4. Common Application (SENIORS):

- 12th graders will need to complete the Common App Match before teachers/counselors can send documents to your colleges
- Be sure to add your colleges in your Common App list or your teachers/counselors cannot send your letters of rec
- If you are using Common App to apply, you must indicate this in your college list in Naviance

• Please do not use your LHS email to create an account for your college applications, as it will not accept emails outside of LHS; you will need to create a personal email to communicate with your colleges

5. Letters of Recommendation for 12th Graders:

- Students should make their teacher request in person, followed by the Naviance request, which will generate an email to the teacher
- Students should use the Teacher Recommendation Request Form to help with the letter writing process, available in guidance & College & Career
- Students must list their colleges in Common App & complete the Common App
 Match in Naviance before staff can send documents
- Students will need to notify their teachers when they have added a new college to their list to request the teacher resend the letter to the new school

6. Financial Aid/FAFSA:

- FAFSA: Students should log on beginning Oct. 1 to fafsa.gov to begin the 2018-19 FAFSA financial aid application & create their FSA ID number; transfer 2016 tax information directly into your FAFSA application using the IRS retrieval option; check FAQ's for required documents
- CSS Profile: If you are applying to a private college you may need to submit the CSS Profile financial aid form; beginning Oct. 1 this form is available online at collegeboard.org; fee waivers are automatically granted to eligible students; for additional info, please view the 2017-18 CSS Profile Guide online
- Scholarships: Stay tuned for additional information available on the guidance website

7. SAT Information:

- The late **registration deadline for the Nov 4 SAT is Oct. 25**; register at collegeboard.org; fee waivers can be used to cover the late fee
- The **regular registration deadline for the Dec. 2 SAT is Nov. 2**; register at collegeboard.org; fee waivers can be used to cover the late fee
- Visit Rm. 116 to pick up your free study guide, register for a collegeboard.org account, and/or request a fee waiver (available to eligible students)

8. ACT Information:

- The registration deadline for the Dec. 9 ACT is Nov. 3; register online, www.act.org
- The **late registration deadline** for the Dec. 9 ACT is Nov. 4-17; fee waivers do not cover the late fee; register online, www.act.org

9. TOEFL Information:

- Computer based English-language test for non-native English speakers who have taken ELL courses in high school
- Ongoing registration and test dates available; register online http://www.ets.org/toefl
- Visit Rm. 116 for free study materials, register for an toefl.org account, and/or request a fee waiver (available to eligible students)

10. PSAT Information:

- All 10th/11th grade students who tested on the PSAT will receive an email in Dec. with their access code to log into collegeboard.org to check scores
- Don't forget to link your collegeboard account with Khan Academy--once your PSAT scores are loaded, you will have a personalized study guide & FREE SAT prep
