SLP 2022 Overview

The Summer Learning Program aims to provide a positive and fun learning experience targeting the core areas of literacy and math.

Overview:

- 4 weeks, 2 sessions of 8 days each; 3 hours a day
- Small class sizes
- July 5 - July 28, 2022 at Pulaski Road School
- Grades Pre-K - 8; 236 students across both sessions
- 69% Grades Pre-K-2
- 18% Grades 3-4
- 13% Grades 5-8





Ms. Kathleen McCormick works every summer to have her SLP students prepare a reader's theater performance for all the participants. The student's work on writing the script, reading with **expression**, **intonation**, and **fluency** in addition to designing the set.



Extended School Year 2022

Overview

The **extended school year program** is provided for thirty days in July and August to those students eligible for twelve month special services/programs in order to prevent substantial regression

Description

- 8:1:2 Special Classes
- 30 days, 6 hours per day
- Related Services including speech, OT, PT, counseling, etc.
- Functional academic learning
- Social skills groups and language launchers
- Community Integration Trips
- Vocational skills training

Participants

- 35 Students participated
- Grades kindergarten to post secondary







- Each STEM Camp - 2 hours per day


Participants:


