Course Description:

Health Education focuses on critical issues, while fostering a desire for accurate information and responsible decision making. This course will expose students to a combination of classroom and activity-based learning experiences to increase their awareness and health behaviors. Personal and social skills will be developed to enhance a healthy lifestyle.

Grading

Quarterly 15% - You will take a quarterly at the end of the marking period that will count for 15% of your grade. Throughout the course you will be given all of the information that will be given on the quarterly.

Tests 45%- This area will count for the largest percentage of your grade. You will be given a number of tests to be completed during the marking period. Review for tests will be handed out. You will take 3 test that will each count for 15% of your grade. Tests are on Resume writing, Interview skills and proper CPR/AED use.

Notebook/Classwork 20%- Participation, sub work, preparedness and anything else done in class will count towards your Classwork grade. Your participation in class will be paramount to you gaining the knowledge necessary in 11th grade health. During class discussion you need to be appropriate and engaged in order to get full credit. Notebook checks will be done at the middle and the end of the marking period. Please make sure that if you miss a day of school you make up your work.

Resume Project 20%- This will be a project that will be required and explained by the instructor. The project will contain a rubric for grading.

Topics to be discussed, but not limited to:

- 1. Resume writing
- 2. Interview skills
- 3. Consent Education
- 4. AED/CPR
