Directions for Making Course Requests 2025-2026 School Year

Deadline to Enter in IC: January 10, 2025

- * Log in to Student Portal for Infinite campus
- * On your home page, you should see a BLUE line that says "Course Registration is currently open."
- * Click on "Course Registration"
- * Select 25-26 WGHS
- * Click "Add Course"
- * Begin adding course units by course number. If adding a year - long course, be sure you are selecting S1 & S2 (2 units total)
- * Click "ADD" next to the course name, and then select "REQUEST"
- * Continue to request classes until you have the full 14 units requested
- * Once you have all 14 units requested, the completion bar will turn GREEN to indicate you have selected all of your required courses
- * Then, select up to 4 additional semester classes as alternative courses by clicking "ADD" and then "ALTERNATE"
 - ** in the event that you do not get a course you requested, we can utilize your alternative choices
- * When the status bar shows 100% complete-- Units: 14/14, Click "Back" on the top left of the screen to see your choices
