- 1. A particular type or category of photography
- 2. measures the sensitivity of the image sensor
- 3. An informal photograph that is taken quickly.
- 4. The opening in a lens through which light passes to enter the camera. Fstop Depth of Field
- 5. The exposure time or the length of time when the sensor inside the camera is exposed to light
- 6. common way of associating the three variables that determine the exposure of a photograph: aperture, shutter speed, and ISO
- 7. \_\_\_\_\_ Balance Setting on your camera used to adjust for different color temperatures of light.
- 8. The zone of sharpness in front of, and behind, the subject on which the lens is focused. Controlled by Aperture/F Stop
- 9. A photograph captured without creating a posed appearance. Uses rules of composition and art elements.
- 10. The person or thing that is being photographed

- 12. Tool you can see in the view finder to help decided if your photo will be too light or too dark. It will change as you adjust the Aperture, Shutter Speed and ISO settings, because each of these effects the amount of light in your photo.
