MAY 5th - EMERGENCY LEVY RENEWAL

- May 5th Emergency Levy Renewal for Mount Vernon City Schools that will combine two existing levies into one.
- Levies first approved in 1982 (\$1,250,000) and 1996 (\$1,652,000) will appear as one issue for a total of \$2,902,000.
- Zero additional taxes.
- Approval of this issue keeps Mount Vernon Schools funding at current levels.

A positive and fun activity for all students and their families!




PARCC/BOWLING COMPETITION


