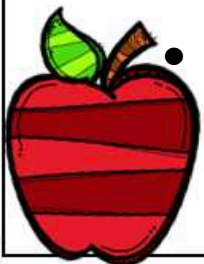

- **ACCIDENT**

- **ACROBAT**

1. A PERSON WHO DOES TRICKS THAT TAKE GREAT STRENGTH AND GOOD CONTROL IN MOVING THE BODY

- **ALARM**

1. A SIGNAL, SUCH AS A BELL OR BUZZER, THAT WARNS PEOPLE OR TELLS THEM TO TAKE ACTION
2. A FEELING THAT SOMETHING IS WRONG OR THAT THERE IS DANGER
3. TO MAKE SOMEONE AFRAID OR FEARFUL

- **BOUNCE**

1. TO SPRING BACK AFTER HITTING SOMETHING

- **ENORMOUS**

1. VERY BIG

- **GAP**

1. AN OPENING OR SPACE IN SOMETHING THAT IS NORMALLY CLOSED

- **SCOOP**

1. A TOOL LIKE A BOWL WITH A HANDLE. IT CAN BE LARGE OR SMALL AND IS USED FOR DIGGING INTO AND LIFTING LOOSE OR SOFT MATERIALS.
2. TO TAKE SOMETHING UP IN A QUICK MOVEMENT

- **SUPPORT**

1. SOMETHING USED TO HOLD AN OBJECT IN PLACE AND TO KEEP IT FROM FALLING
2. TO HOLD SOMETHING IN PLACE OR TO KEEP IT FROM FALLING

- **TANGLE**

1. TO MIX-UP OF THINGS TWISTED OR KNOTTED TOGETHER
2. TO BECOME TWISTED OR KNOTTED TOGETHER

- **WEIGH**

1. TO FIND OUT HOW HEAVY SOMETHING IS

- **WEIGHT**
