Kool-Aid Playdough Recipe

An easy homemade kool-aid playdough recipe!

Prep Time	Cook Time
5 mins	5 mins
Keywords: kool-aid playdough, playdough recipe, Playdough, 1 hour of playdough	
Equipment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spoon, Pin or Rod • Rolling Wheel 	
Ingredients <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 cup flour • 2 tsp cream of tartar • 1/2 tsp salt • 2 packets Kool-aid • 1 tsp vegetable oil (do not use olive oil as it stains color of kool-aid packet) • 1 cup water 	
Instructions <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In a large bowl, combine all of your dry ingredients (flour, cream of tartar, salt, 2 Kool-Aid packets) and mix well. 2. Add the vegetable oil and water to a pot. Mix together. 3. Add the dry ingredients to your pot and mix well. 4. Cook on low to medium heat until dough starts to form and become dry. 5. Once a ball of dough starts to form and the playdough looks fully cooked, remove from the heat and let the dough cool before touching. If you wanted to extra Kool-aid packets, it may take longer to cook. Just keep mixing until the dough forms. 6. After the dough has cooled, knead it for 5 minutes to make the dough soft and smooth.

The cream of tartar is optional, but if not used the playdough will not last as long. It is used as a preservative. The kool-aid is for color and it makes it smell good but if you do not have any food coloring will also work. We are also attaching this video showing how to make playdough with Jello.
