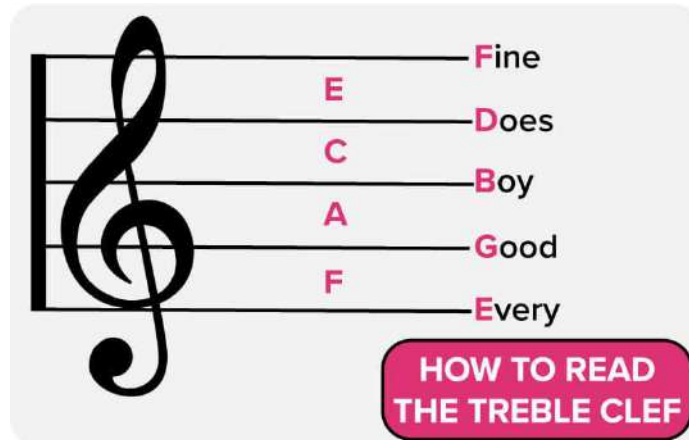


Second Grade Music Adventures!

Choose Game #4: Note Name Memory

Choose Level 1 to begin and then move to Level 2 afterwards for an added challenge

- Select "Notes in Spaces" to review the space notes. Remember the space notes spell "FACE"
- Select "Notes on Lines" to review the line notes. You can remember the line notes with a poem like "Every Good Boy Does Fine"
- Once you get good at naming the line and space notes separately, select "notes on the staff" to play the game with both lines and spaces mixed together!
