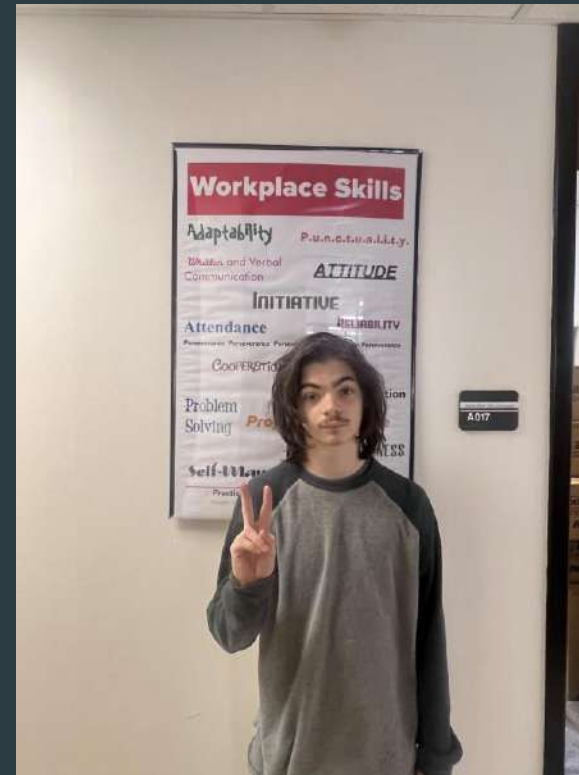
Jordan Knightes is the star student for the Carpentry Program this month.
