2. Twenty- six (26.0) credits are needed for graduation. For the Class of 2013 and beyond, 0.5 credits must be taken in an online course. These courses are designated with online in the course title. As an example, *0800ONL Accounting I Online*. Be sure to review the specific requirements for graduation set forth in the **COURSE DESCRIPTION BOOKLET** (starting on page 4). **It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all graduation requirements are met.**

3. Each student must schedule 6 credits per semester **plus** physical education for a total of 6.25 credits or you will not be able to **"Submit"** your requests. **Courses with 1.00 credit value are full year and courses with .50 credit value are half year. PE is the exception worth .25 credit, however, can be either a full year or half year depending on your science course.**

4. Be sure to check prerequisites for all courses, which are listed with the specific course. Sequential subjects in math, science, and foreign language require a C or better to move to the next level. The "College in High School" classes are preceded with a CHS and may be eligible for college credit. If you are requesting AP or Honors classes, the student **must** consult with his/her current teacher in the department and have the teacher submit an electronic recommendation within the teacher's gradebook.

To Request Courses:

- **Online scheduling opens on February 14th and closes February 23rd.**
- Log onto your PowerSchool account and choose the **Class Registration** Icon.
- Click on the **Edit** button, the **Pencil**. A window appears. Click to the left of course in which you were recommended. You can only register for courses in which you meet the prerequisites.
- Click **Okay** when finished. After all categories have been fulfilled, click **Submit**.

Caution: The parent/student portal could time out after 45 minutes of inactivity.

After submitting, please print the 2011-2012 Course Requests screen. (Print an additional copy for your records.) Have your parents sign and date the sheet.

The due date for submitting requests online and returning your signed "Course Request" printout to the Counseling Office is **February 23rd.**
