Parents & Caregivers: PUT SAFETY FIRST AT DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS SITUATION: Recently we've had some parents and caregivers violating our safety rules for drop-off and pick-up in the front circle. This cannot continue.

<u>Remember</u>: Children must **NEVER** be dropped off or picked up from the <u>outer lane of traffic in the circle</u>; this requires the child to cross the inner lane of traffic and could result in a tragic accident. <u>Nothing justifies putting our children at</u> <u>risk</u>. PLEASE make sure that <u>all</u> members of your household who are responsible for getting your children to and from school understand and follow our safety rules.
