A. Summer reading

- 2. In each book, please mark one area that you find to be thought-provoking. These passages may be as long as several paragraphs or as limited as a simple quote. You will share these with the class when school begins.
- 3. While you will not have a written response to complete during the summer to hand in, you will take an objective test on both books the first week of school.
- 4. Our discussions and assignments pertaining to the books will include, but not be limited to, the following questions:
 - a) What makes the characters unique?
 - b) Both of these books can be considered a quest. What are the characters searching for? What obstacles stand in the way of the characters? Do they achieve their goals?
 - c) What makes the main characters change? Is the change voluntary?
 - d) How does the author use setting to develop mood and theme?
- B. Required reading during the school year.

 - 3. The Odyssey This is in the literature book.
 - 4. Lord of the Flies Copies are available.
