LEXIS SHERRON DEFENDS BVMS SPELLING BEE TITLE

There's a trend going on at Brandon Valley Middle School, as recent year school spelling and geography bee competitions have churned out repeat winners.

For three consecutive years, now freshman Robert Haggar walked away with a trio of BVMS Geography Bee titles. And for the second consecutive year, Lexis Sherron spelled her way to victory of the 2012 BVMS Spelling Bee. Sherron pulled off the

feat as a sixth grader in the inaugural year of the local school event, and said she was determined to do it again. "I wanted to win," the seventh grader admits, "but I didn't want people to think mean things of me."

BVMS Principal Dan Pansch said any one of this year's 10 finalists could've won. "You noticed how close she came to not repeating," Pansch said. "Will she do it three times? I don't know, but it was pretty clear it took some work."

Unlike last year, Sherron, a straight A student, said she didn't put in as much pre-spelling bee practice time as she did the previous year, but said a couple of items she now has aided in her repeat victory. "I got a Kindle Fire for Christmas that has a built-in dictionary and I won a dictionary at last year's spelling bee," she said.

Sherron now has five weeks to prepare for the regional level of the Scripps Spelling Bee competition, which she took first place at in 2011. That competition is scheduled for Feb. 11 in Sioux Falls. If she is victorious at the regional level, Sherron will advance to the state spelling bee, where she also had some success, finishing second to West River's Ryder Heitz. That competition will be held on the University of South Dakota campus in Vermillion.

TEACHER OF THE YEAR

The Brandon Valley School District and First National Bank have once again joined in partnership to recognize a Brandon Valley "Teacher of the Year" for the 2011-2012 school year.

Parents, students and teachers are encouraged to nominate a Brandon Valley teacher to receive this award. Nomination forms may be obtained from any district principal's office or the office of the superintendent. Forms need to be submitted with two (2) letters of recommendation attached no later than Friday, April 13, 2012.

Those teachers nominated will be sent an application form to be completed and returned to the Superintendent's Office for review by a selection committee consisting of representatives from school, business and parents. This committee will have the difficult decision of selecting one winner from the top three finalists. All candidates and finalists will be recognized at the Brandon Valley Retirement and Recognition Banquet on Tuesday, May 1, 2012.
