Virtual/Online Opportunities for Students

The School District of the Menomonie Area is proud to renew our partnership with Wisconsin Digital Learning Collaborative for a fifth year. This partnership provides student's with an opportunity to participate in an online education through their local school district. The program was developed to better serve the unmet needs of some of our students and move toward preparing ALL students for the 21st century skills they will be required to demonstrate in their futures.

The School District of Menomonie will be partnering with Wisconsin Digital Learning Collaborative to provide viable course options for our students. WDLC serves school districts, helping us provide virtual learning options for our students, including:

- ✓ Modified rates of learning to accommodate the student – traditional, accelerated or extended
- ✓ The experience of online learning in preparation for future training in post-secondary educational and work environments.

Course Information

Menomonie Virtual courses are aligned to national and state standards. Course goals and objectives will be available upon request. Students currently enrolled at MHS full-time can enrich their course selection with courses not currently offered at MHS. Courses cannot supplant courses offered on-site. Students in a full-time home-based learning environment have access to all available coursework.

All offerings are one or two semester courses for both fall and spring terms. The number of concurrent courses, being completed at any one time, will be determined by the school district. Each student will develop a virtual education plan. All courses are taught by Wisconsin DPI certified teachers.
