Many of these items can be used from year to year. Please feel free to reuse items.

KINDERGARTEN:

Please explain to your child that most supplies will be stored together and used as needed. However, please put your child's name on their backpack and folders.

- 1 Backpack, standard size, no mini packs. Backpack must be large enough to hold the homework folder. Put full name on backpack
- 2 plastic, pronged, folders with pockets on the bottom, not the sides. Put name inside folders
- 2 boxes (24-count each) Crayola brand crayons
- 12 #2 Dixon Ticonderoga brand pencils. Note: please sharpen pencils.
- 1 box (12-count) Crayola colored pencils regular length, already sharpened
- 24 Elmer's brand Glue sticks
- 1 Fiskars scissors
- 1 container Clorox brand wipes
- 2 Dry erase markers, black, fine tip
- 1 set Crayola brand water color paints
- 1 bottle liquid glue
- Boys—1 box Ziploc sandwich size bags and/or 1 box Ziploc snack size bags
- Girls—1 box tissue (Kleenex) and/or 1 box Ziploc gallon size Ziploc bags

FIRST GRADE:

Please mark your student's name only on his/her school box, scissors and crayons.
