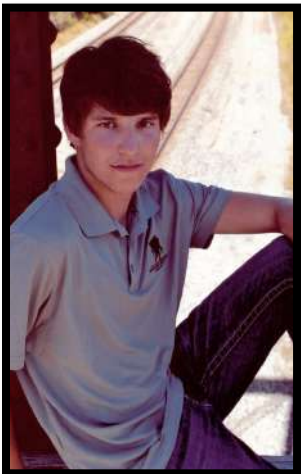
Joeshph Allen Crowe
