- > The course must be non-remedial and have a strong history of transfer to other colleges and universities.
- All college resources, such as tutoring, advising, and supportive services for students with special needs must be available.
- > Students may not enroll in more than two courses per college semester.
- > Students will receive one high school credit for each successfully completed college course.
- > Students are responsible to submit an official transcript to receive McGuffey High School credit.

Eligible Students

- McGuffey High School juniors or seniors
- The student is making satisfactory progress toward graduation.
- A minimum score of "Proficient" on the Keystone Algebra I, Literature, and Biology Assessments.
- A minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- A demonstrated readiness for college-level course work in the intended subject area of study.
- > Satisfactory attendance and citizenship, as determined by the school district.
