






How does our school's achievement over time compare to the district and the state?

Next Generation MCAS (Average Scaled Score)




Legacy MCAS (CPI)

The Composite Performance Index (CPI) is a number from 1-100 that represents the extent to which all students are progressing toward proficiency in a given subject. 


Elementary Schools in MA
