Qualifications and Instructions

1. Applicant must be high school senior who has exhibited academic achievement, character and economic need.
2. Student must plan to attend a university or junior college the fall semester following high school graduation.
3. Applicant must have completed or be in the process of completing the EverFi Financial Literacy Program.
4. Applications must be submitted on the scholarship form or a photocopy of the form. Attachments must include an official transcript with ACT scores, two letters of recommendation, a resume of extracurricular activities and personal statement of financial need.
5. The application form **must** be signed by a bank officer from your local bank which sponsors the EverFi program for your school.
6. The scholarship selection committee is the final and binding judge of scholarship recipients.
7. **Applications must be postmarked by March 10, 2017.**
