
## Cohort Results by Graduating Class Percent Proficient or Advanced





#### 2014-2019 PSSA English/Language Arts Cohort Results






### Keystone End of Course Results by Proficiency Level and 3-Year Trend (First time testers only)








### 2019 End of Course Tested Keystone Results Students with Disabilities


### Keystone End of Course Results by Percent Proficient or Advanced, Proficiency Level and 3-Year Trend




### Keystone End of Course Results by Percent Proficient or Advanced, Proficiency Level and 3-Year Trend





**Class of 2018 Keystone Exam Proficiency** Percent Students at Each Proficiency Level







### Classes of 2018, 2019 and 2020 Keystone Proficiency at End of Grade 11 3-Year Trend by Subject










Percent Students at Each Proficiency Level
















### 2019 SAT Evidence-Based Reading Results

Average Score by Year


