Meet Information:

- 1. Coaches meeting at 2:30 at the finish line.
- 2. Bathroom facilities will be open, but please have athletes come dressed to compete.
- 3. Entries will be unlimited
- 4. **1/4"** pyramid spikes will be allowed on all jumping and running surfaces. No other spikes will be allowed on the running/jumping surfaces.
- 5. We will have a Thrower's Relay and each team is limited to $\underline{\mathbf{1}}$ thrower relay per gender (athletes in this relay may not be entered in a running event)
- 6. The Shot Put and Discus rings are on concrete slabs and the Javelin event is located on a grass field.
- 7. The Long and Triple Jumps events will have (3) attempts, with the top 9 advancing to finals.
- 8. The Shot Put, Discus & Javelin will have (3) attempts, with the top 9 advancing to finals.
- 9. The Pole Vault starting height for Boys and Girls will be determined at the coaches meeting.
- 10. The High Jump starting height for Boys and Girls will be determined at the coaches meeting.
- 11. Each school must furnish all personal items, equipment, towels, etc.
- 12. No tape is allowed on the track. Teams are responsible for their own markers for relay zones.
- 13. Teams may set up camps outside of the track. No camps allowed on the infield.
- 14. Have buses unload your teams on the south side of the track
- 15. Concessions will be available.
- 16. Meet conduct and eligibility will follow the rules of the NDHSAA
- 17. <u>Entry Fee</u>: There will be a \$125.00 entry fee per gender. Entry fees can be mailed or hand delivered on same day of meet. Make checks payable to **Sheyenne High School**. (Send to address in letterhead).

Admission for spectators will be \$6.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students
