Oak Leaf History

The tradition of the Oak Leaf Award originated in 1933 when the senior class requested to conduct their awards assembly beneath a majestic white oak tree on the campus of Eichelberger High School. With the building of the new Hanover High School in 1965 the tradition continued under a direct descendant of the original oak. The tree on the front lawn of 401 Moul Avenue was germinated on the grounds of Eichelberger High School over 40 years ago, and was moved to its present location in 1970.

The tree now serves as the backdrop for the presentation of the Oak Leaf Awards. A new tradition was established in 1995 when commencement activities were moved to the front lawn. As each member of the senior graduating class enters, the oak tree is touched to signify his/her connection to Hanover High School's proud history. As the seniors become one with all other Hanover graduates, they simultaneously draw energy from the past and add vitality.

The oak tree is symbolic of strength, and our Oak Leaf Award represents strength in character, strength in leadership, and strength in dependability. The male and female recipients of this award are determined by a majority vote of the high school faculty. The pin that is given carries immeasurable honor. It carries with it no monetary value. It is not earned as a result of successfully completing certain requirements; but it carries with it a most large tradition. The recipient of the Oak Leaf Award traditionally has been that student who best represents what this community expects from its educational program. This is not an award limited only to scholastic achievement, or athletic prowess. This recipient does not merely excel in one subject area or exhibit talents in only one arena. The recipient of this award enters the greater community having demonstrated all that is best.
