APPLICANT GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

DEFINITION:

- 1. Cash Award
- 2. For one academic year

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Applicant must be a veteran, active duty military member, guard or reserve, or dependent as defined by the veteran's administration.
- 2. Applicant must have a High School diploma or General Educational Development (GED) certificate. If applicant has neither, they must submit a detailed explanation of their plans and goals.
- 3. Applicant must show proof of acceptance to an accredited college, technology center, or training institution.
- 4. Enrollment must be for at least one-half time for each enrollment session.
- 5. Enrollment can include remedial, refresher and deficiency type course work.
- 6. Prerequisite course work, training experiences and regular course work must be towards a specific degree or program.
- 7. Dropped course work or complete withdrawal from session will constitute reimbursement of scholarship funds, unless mitigating reasons are given in writing to the Oklahoma Veterans Council Scholarship committee that show applicant's actions were due to circumstances beyond their control.
- 8. Grades from the previous semester, trimester or grading period must be equivalent to a "C" average.
- 9. Other tuition/fees, waiver funds or other scholarships will not disqualify the recipient from use of these scholarship funds.
- 10. Continued achievement can result in the recipient reapplying for this scholarship for multiple years. However, reapplication for this scholarship is not a guarantee that a past year recipient would automatically be selected. Open competition is the rule, but past recipients who are highly successful would have their chance of being reselected greatly enhanced.

SCHOLARSHIP USES & DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS:

- 1. Recipient will be awarded a one-time payment before October of the year of entrance in a qualified program.
- 2. Award can be used for student fees, P.E. fees, lab fees, music fees, books, materials, supplies, equipment, or necessary uniforms.
- 3. Award can be used for all time periods semesters, training time period, etc. (whichever is more advantageous to the recipient).

APPLICATION MUST HAVE:

- 1. Completed scholarship application form.
- 2. Copy of DD-214 with any 215's (discharge/separation papers), proof of service (i.e. pay statement), and if a dependent a copy of ID card (front and back).
- 3. Copy of one of the following: latest high school transcript, GED, latest college transcript, or vocational training paperwork.

COMPLETED APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED OR POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN JULY 1, 2018.
